BHS Scholarships Scholarship applications for the BHS scholarships are now available for ANY college. Deadline has been extended until April 12 (just before vacation). Applications are available online at the BHS homepage. The Scholarship Committee would like parents to know that we use three criteria for choosing award recipients: academics, contributions and activities at BHS, and most importantly, **unmet financial need**. There are no merit scholarships per se given out through this program. To make fair decisions, the Committee requires that families make out the CSS Profile financial aid form, available at CollegeBoard.com.
