Pass/Fail Guidelines

Brookline High School will use 70% COMPLETION of assignments as the passing standard during our remote learning period.

Typically, a student with a 60% average or above would earn a passing grade. During the school closure, however, teachers are NOT grading for ACCURACY or CORRECTNESS. Rather, the 70% threshold reflects students' EFFORT, ENGAGEMENT and COMPLETION.

Semester 2 will be graded as Pass/Fail

- Keeping in mind that every family, every teacher, and every student is responding to the crisis in their own way, determining how students Pass or Fail in this environment is challenging.
- We know that high school students often stress over grades so we are sharing our intentions for evaluating the credits earned this school year.
- Teachers will share with their students the expectations for passing semester 2, an established practice at BHS.

What do I need to do to pass?

Connect, Engage, Turn in

- **Connect** with your teachers and peers, communicate with your teachers weekly
- **Engage** in the learning process by working on assignments
- **Turn in** work! Make sure the work is your own as the Cheating and Plagiarism rules are in effect.
