

Public Schools of Brookline is Offering Free & Reduced Student Meals During Precautionary School Closures

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Public Schools of Brookline are temporarily closed as a precaution aimed at stemming the Coronavirus outbreak. During this Precautionary School Closure, we will continue to offer meals to students who qualify for free or reduced meals at no cost through our online student ordering system. Students 18 years old and under, who qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch, can order Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner online and have it available for curbside pick-up at one of three locations: Coolidge Corner School, Pierce School or Brookline High School.

If your student qualifies, use the link to the district's website below to preorder their meals online through the "**Out of School Ordering System.**" Step by step instructions are available on how to place an order at <https://publicschoolsofbrooklineschoolnutrition.com>

The menu includes pre-packaged, take-home meal options - subject to change based upon availability. Each student may order a day's meal to include **1 breakfast and 2 lunches** per day. Pick up is available Monday, Wednesday and Friday between 12:00 PM – 1:30 PM. Exact locations are below:

- Coolidge Corner: Stedman Street Entrance
- Pierce: Pierce Historical Building Circle
- Brookline High School: Tappan Street Gym

While picking up meals, do not get out of the vehicle. Someone will bring the packaged meals to your car.
