
Junior Year Timeline 2017

FEBRUARY

- * Students – Review PSAT scores online- See your counselor if no access
- Students – Attend the Tues 2/7 REQUIRED T block Junior Assembly in the Auditorium
- Students and Parents – Attend Junior Night Wed 2/8
- Arrange college visits for Feb vacation, if ready
- Research interesting summer courses, jobs, or activities - Substitute Career counselor support in College / Career Center Room 279 – Thurs X blocks
- Feb 10 – Deadline for March 11 SAT registration (2/28 late deadline)
- * Ongoing – Schedule appt with your guidance counselor to develop preliminary college list

MARCH

- March 3 – Deadline to register for April 8 ACT (late deadline 3/17)
- * March 11 – SAT (no Subject Tests)
- March 16 evening– Attend BHS College Fair - Cafe
- March 21-23 - Attend REQUIRED Junior Guidance Seminars (ELA MCAS week)
- Ongoing – Schedule appt with your guidance counselor to develop preliminary college list
- Plan challenging but balanced senior year course load
- Consider registering for SAT Subject tests in AP courses you are finishing this year

APRIL

- Arrange college visits for April vacation, if ready
- April 7 – Deadline to register for May 6 SAT
- April 8 - ACT
- Ongoing – Schedule appt with your guidance counselor to develop preliminary college list
- Investigate colleges by researching using resources – Naviance, college homepage, college guides – books and online, visits to campuses
- Begin to identify teachers whom you may ask for recommend

MAY

- May 9 – Deadline to register for June 3 SAT (late deadline 5/24)
- May 5 – Deadline to register for June 10 ACT (late deadline 5/19)
- May 6– SAT or SAT Subject Tests
- AP exams, if appropriate
- Continue to evaluate your college list and meet with your guidance counselor. Eliminate colleges from the original list that no longer interest you and add others as appropriate
- Continue to identify teachers whom you may ask for recommendations

JUNE

- June 3 – SAT or SAT Subject Tests
- June 10 – ACT
- Continue college search
- Arrange college visits and/or interviews for summer
- Continue to work hard on junior year courses and prep for final exams
- * Ask two teachers to write recommendations if you haven't already done

SUMMER

- Continue to work on college list
- Explore Early Decision / Early Action options
- Study for SAT/ ACT if necessary
- Continue extracurricular and community service activities
- Earn money for college
- Get a head start on the college application process by writing a college essay draft and creating your activities resume
