

On June 29, 2023, the U.S. Supreme Court announced its ruling holding that the use of race in admissions policies applied by the University of North Carolina and Harvard College violates the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

Harvard: The Court also ruled that colleges and universities may consider in admissions decisions "an applicant's discussion of how race affected his or her life, be it through discrimination, inspiration, or otherwise."


NAVIANCE GRAPH: SAFETY, MATCH OR REACH?




